Overview and update

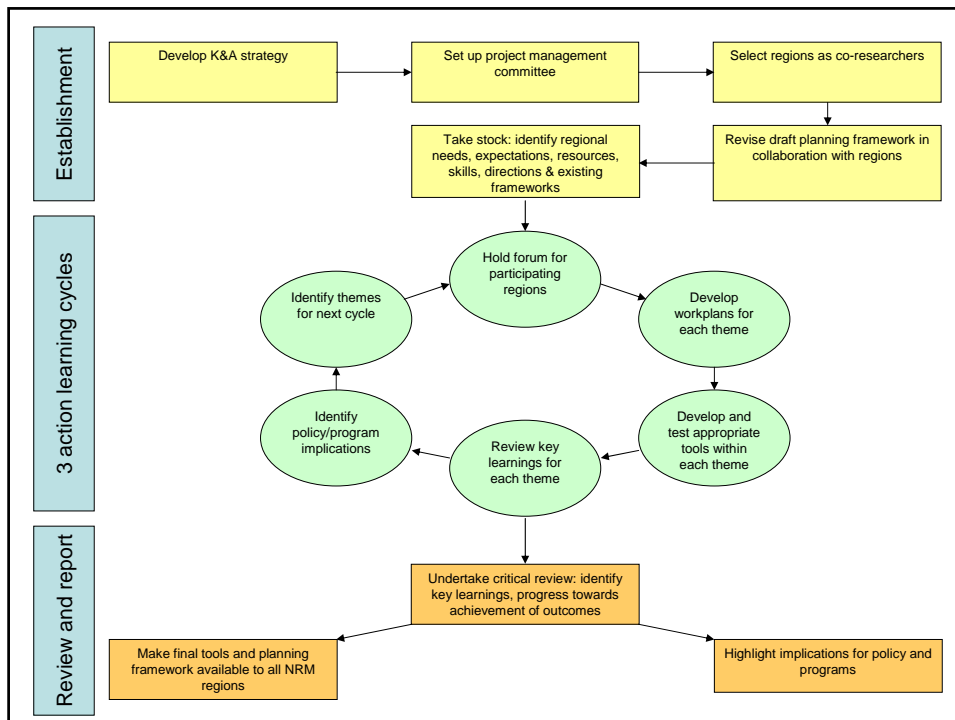
Objective:

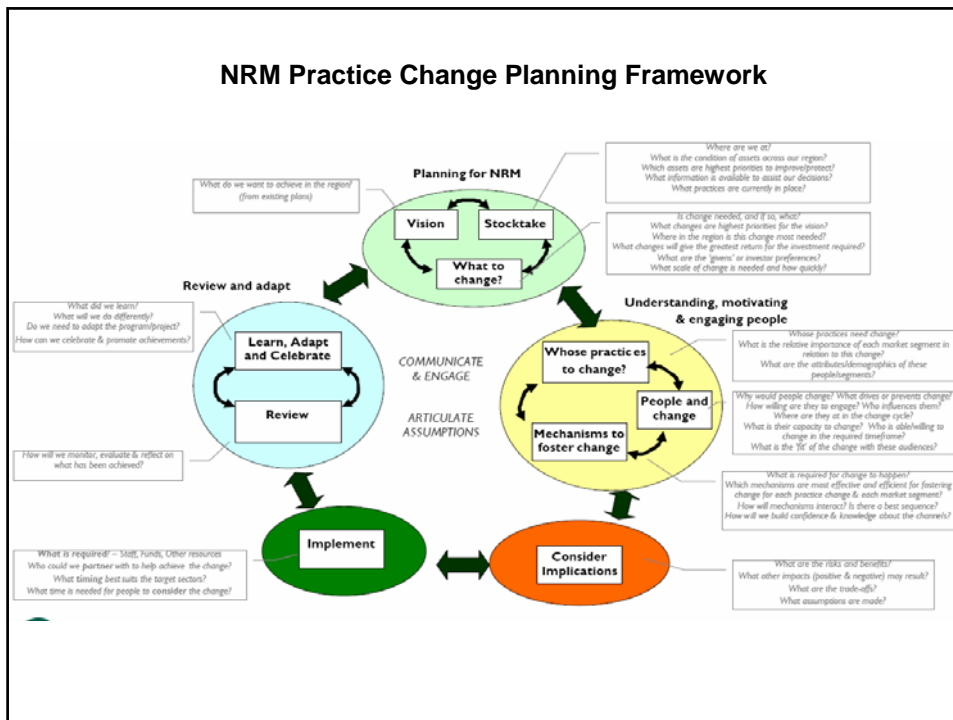
